Know that you...

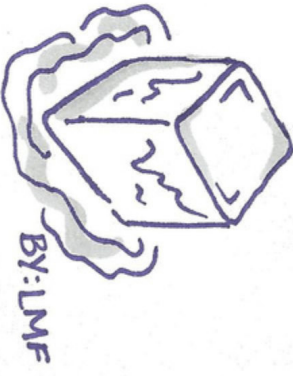
- Do NOT have to say if a particular employee is working on that day or not;

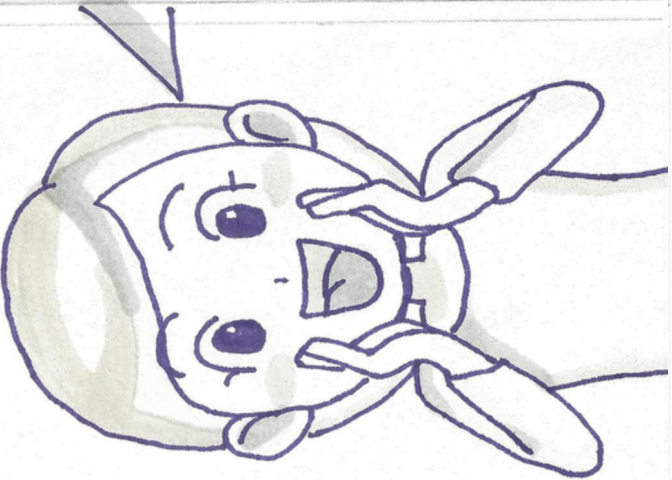
Solidarity in immigration hellscape.

You have the right to play "dumb."
